Transportation Discipline Procedure

We recognize the importance of a partnership between the Fenton Area School District, parents and students to provide a safe environment for transportation on our busses and students are expected to:

- Board and exit the bus properly
- Refrain from public displays of affection
- Follow all bus safety procedures
- Use only appropriate language
- Follow the student code of conduct as described in the Student Handbook
- Treat the Bus driver with courtesy, respect, and following all requests promptly and politely

This list of expectations is not all inclusive and other behaviors may give rise to discipline, serious misconduct (i.e. drugs or drug paraphernalia, tobacco, weapons, alcohol, fighting) may result in immediate suspension of bus and school privileges.

When a student chooses to deviate from appropriate behavior (except for serious misconduct), the steps for consequences will be as follows:

- First Violation:** The student will receive a written warning.
- Second Violation:** The student may be suspended from bus privileges for (3) three school days.
- Third Violation:** The student may be suspended from bus privileges for (10) ten school days.
- Fourth Violation:** The student may be suspended from bus privileges for (90) ninety school days.
- Fifth Violation:** The student may be suspended from bus privileges for the remainder of the school year.

Your child's bus driver will contact parent/guardian by telephone for each violation.
